Minimum Entries

6 is the minimum number of pre-entries which must be received for each Class and/or Division.

If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the **Compulsory Competition Classes will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules – Chapter 1, Rule 9.**

Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or Cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.

If a Class or Division is cancelled, the Entry Fee will be refunded in accordance with the Rules.

Entry Details Confirmation

In lieu of an administration checking session, an Official Entry List including class, race numbers and transponder numbers will be posted on the Official Notice Board the afternoon of Thursday, 21 August 2025. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all information on the Official Entry List is correct. Any inaccuracies or discrepancies are required to be notified to the Chief Timekeeper prior to the start of on-track Competition.

Communication during the Event

Each Driver must advise the Stewards Secretary of any changes to their registered mobile phone number for the Driver to receive SMS communication. Individual calls over the public-address system will be minimal.

If a Notification is sent to a Driver, they must report to the Stewards Secretary as soon as possible and within 30 minutes of the Notification being sent. Non-attendance within 30 minutes will result in the automatic issuing of your penalty by the Stewards.
